Public Notice Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation Operational Evaluation Report

The **City of Venus** water system PWS ID **1260006** has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems in exceedance of an operational evaluation level are required to conduct an evaluation of their source water, treatment and distribution operations and submit a report of their findings to the TCEQ.

We failed to conduct an operational evaluation and/or submit a report to the TCEQ.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

The City no longer treats the drinking water and relies totally on surface water supplied by City of Midlothian. The City also has a flushing program and has increased the amount of flushing in order to keep a good water age in the water distribution system..
