

Animal Ordinance NO. 447-2017

Effective February 2017

The Animal Ordinance was passed and adopted by the City of Venus Council on February 13, 2017.

This ordinance can be found on www.cityofvenus.net and includes the following items:

- Every owner of cat or dog which is four (4) months of age and is kept in the city, shall register the animal with the city every two (2) years.
 - A registration tag will be provided and the tag shall be placed on the collar or harness while the animal is outside the owner's residence.
- All dogs living within the city limits of the City of Venus are required to have a microchip.
 - o Animal must be implanted with a registered microchip before six (6) months of age.
 - A current registration with a microchip registration company shall be maintained.
 - o If any dog is impounded and is not microchipped, the dog shall be microchipped before it is released at the cost of the owner.
 - The city shall promote events where microchipping services are provided at a low-cost.
- It is unlawful to own a large number of animals within the city.
- It shall be unlawful for anyone to leave or confine any animal in any standing or parked vehicle.
- It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, give away any animal in a public place.
- It shall be unlawful for any person who owns a dog to permit that dog to run at large.
 - This is an exception for dogs on a leash which shall not exceed a lead of six (6) feet in length.
 - o Extendable lead leashes are **prohibited**.
 - A ticket may be issued without warning for an offense under section 6-12 (Dog restraint).
- It shall be unlawful for a dog owner to allow the dog to defecate in public without properly removing and disposing all excreta deposited on the property by the dog.
- It shall be unlawful for a dog owner to leave a dog outside and unattended using a restraint (chain, rope, etc.) attached to a stationary object which limits the dog's movement.
- A proper living area is required for any outside dogs and it shall be at least 150 square feet for each six months of age or older.

Penalty

- Any person violating provisions of this chapter shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor with a fine in an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
- Any person violating section 6-2 (Dog Registration), upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
