The documentation listed must be submitted with the application for a Certificate of Appropriateness (COA).

REMODELING, ADDITIONS, AND NEW CONSTRUCTION					
		Applications for new construction and major remodels must be reviewed by the City Planner prior to the submittal deadline.			
		Scaled and dimensioned elevation and plan drawings indicating proposed alterations or additions, clearly indicating the existing building and what is proposed and including the relationship to adjacent structures.			
		Site plan showing: 1) dimensions of lot, 2) location and dimensions of the structure and addition (if applicable), and 3) location of all exterior, ground and roof mounted equipment.			
		Official site survey			
		Specifications, images of all proposed exterior materials including siding, doors, windows, lighting, and roof shingles.			
		Paint chips or specifications (brand, color name) and placement on the structure
